



Wilson Language Applied Methods Workshop

Three-day Applied Methods Workshop – Prerequisite for All Levels

The WRS Applied Methods Workshop is a 15-hour workshop that provides the practice and guidance needed to effectively begin implementing the Wilson Reading System in our Intervention Model Setting. The Intervention Model targets students beyond grade 3 who are reading or spelling below grade level, and is implemented in small groups and reading classes in the general education classroom, after-school programs, literacy and adult education settings. The workshop introduces the general program concepts and provides instruction in the lesson plan format targeted for a group setting.

The Applied Methods Workshop fulfills the prerequisite requirement for all other WRS professional development and required to join Wilson Academy.

(Upon completion, participants are generally able to begin using the materials. However, they are not considered trained in the Wilson Reading System and should not charge fees for Wilson tutoring.)
