



Fountas & Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention Training

Capital Region BOCES is pleased to announce a training for the newly released, research-based Fountas & Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI). The LLI is a supplemental early intervention for small-groups of one to three students, designed for young children who struggle with reading and writing. LLI will meet requirements for RTI as it is intended to accelerate literacy development to bring children up to grade-level performance in as little as 18-24 weeks. LLI small groups meet daily for 30 minutes and are in addition to regular classroom instruction.

The Fountas & Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention is designed to be used as part of a school-based intervention plan and/or RTI plan for grades K-3. Each intervention system consists of:

- Texts specifically developed that are interesting and motivating for children
- Detailed teacher support for each lesson
- Professional readings on struggling readers
- Numerous teacher resources including a CD with demonstrations, program guides and prompting guide
- Flexible tools that can be customized for monitoring student progress and data management
