Leveled Literacy Intervention Support Network

Capital Region BOCES is pleased to announce the Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) Support Network. This network is intended to support teachers and schools as they implement the Fountas and Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention. The LLI Network provides a forum for teachers to come together across schools to reflect and discuss LLI implementation issues, share expertise, as well as read and discuss professional reading that enhance teacher knowledge in accelerating children's literacy development. The LLI Network will be offered for four sessions after school. Each session will focus on an appropriate topic that will support LLI implementation with opportunities for discussion and sharing of ideas, problem-solving, examining student work, and discussion of professional readings in When Readers Struggle along with and other related articles. Once the LLI Network is up and running, participants will be able to shape the agendas to better meet group needs for subsequent meetings.

The structure of each monthly session will include a similar format:

- Sharing and problem-solving
- Examining student work from LLI lessons
- Discussion of readings on an appropriate LLI topic
- Video segment – discussion and reflection on an aspect of an LLI lesson
- Action plans and agenda setting for next session

What follows is a sample list of monthly topics to be revised by participants in the LLI network.

- Using children's strengths and needs
- Using the Prompting Guide and Literacy Continuum
- Word Learning
- Shifts in Writing
- Fluency across the lesson
- Writing Development to support reading development
- Comprehension across the lesson

Email support will be available for participants and a LLI blog if interested. In addition, school or district site specific meeting.

This study group on RTI is facilitated by Linda Carr, a literacy consultant, as well as former Supervisor of the Literacy Center and ELA Supervisor in South Colonie. Linda's extensive background in literacy instruction and assessment strategies and experience working with schools to improve student literacy achievement will enhance participant's use of LLI.
