



It Ain't Rtl 'til It's Cooking in Tier 1! A Recipe for Reaching and Teaching All Students

If we embrace Rtl to also mean "Regular Teacher Involvement," "Research to Implementation," and "Realistic Technology Integration," one can more easily articulate a framework of what it means to teach and learn in the 21st Century.

This two-day "Cooking Class" is designed for teams of Educators and Administrators who wish to blend their Rtl "ingredients" and cook a delicious "learning buffet" for the school community – or in other words - plan an engaging, rigorous and relevant accessible curriculum for all students.

We will review the "ingredients" for curriculum planning in relation to evidence-based programs and practices recommended by the Partnership for 21st Century Skills. We will then explore a range of student centered technology tools that support effective classroom instruction at Tier One.

Each team will be given a planning template on which to build a model plan that reflects the science and practice of implementing evidence-based programs, practices and technology tools. We will share plans as well as develop consensus for ways to "satisfy our hunger for more nourishment" beyond the two day Rtl Cooking Course.
